

#### AMBER MAJORS, ST. LOUIS CITY LOCATION

"Back in August of 2023, the week of prayer and fasting fell during a time when I was personally experiencing a great deal of crippling and debilitating anxiety. When I showed up to prayer, I learned that the focus that week would be on healing. I sat there wondering, was the anxiety I was dealing with "worth" bringing up? The answer to that question is a resounding YES.

That is what I love about the WEEK of Prayer and Fasting... and showing up consecutively. Though I didn't find the courage to ask for prayer that first day, I came back the next day ready to engage my faith and share what I was dealing with. With my Community Group around me, we prayed over the crippling anxiety I had been experiencing, and I felt such a sense of peace. I realized by the end of the week that ever since that moment of prayer, I hadn't experienced any anxiety the rest of the week and had a renewed sense of peace around facing the unknowns that I was navigating. In fact, as more time has passed I can look back and see this moment as a true turning point in my year."

#### MATT HOLZ II, WASHINGTON LOCATION

"Recently, I started a new job that is closer to Washington. During our last prayer and fasting the Lord spoke to me through a couple of men in our church and helped me settle my mind about taking the job. The new job came with a decent pay cut for an hourly employee, however, I truly felt as if I was supposed to work closer to home, my "Jerusalem." Well I finally started working at the new place at the beginning of the month. Since I started, my new employer has been scrambling to ensure that I get a full 40 hours of work since he wasn't used to having an extra set of hands. The first couple of weeks, my pay was short and my third week was as well, however he gave me the pay on the third week to compensate for the lack of hours. That weekend the Holy Spirit told me to give that extra pay to the church, along with upping my tithe. In both matters I kept asking Him if that was really Him and telling Him I don't always feel like I have enough. I ended that conversation with God doing what He told me and saying to Him 'I believe in you, help me with my unbelief.' On Monday my new employer called me and said, while I know we agreed to you not getting a raise for six months, I'm going to up your hourly rate beginning today. I immediately thought of the previous Friday and my prayer to God to help me with my unbelief."

Thanks to your generosity Jubilee Family, 227 backpacks were donated to help kids for the 2023-2024 school year containing over \$10,000 worth of school supplies.

"This past year we have been able to serve Hancock Elementary in several ways, with one being providing them with backpacks for their students for the upcoming school year. At Hancock Elementary, the administration told us that they have many families in need who otherwise would not have been able not have backpacks or new school supplies for the school year. In addition, we sent a team to Turkey after the tragic earthquake that struck the nation.

#### **Turkey**

#### EMILY SHULTZ, JUBILEE CITY

When I first learned of the opportunity to go to Antioch and serve at Newfrontiers' relief camp, I knew it was something God would have me do. My heart broke over the loss of more than 60,000 lives, not to mention the complete destruction of the city of Antioch. After prayer and many conversations, God provided the funds for me to go through Jubilee's generous giving. For a week I got to serve alongside Turkish Christians where we distributed food and water daily, ran a school for the kids in the community, and ministered to the neighborhood through prayer, teaching, and worship.

Though I was only there for a week, I saw God working in powerful ways, and He still is! We saw a teenager give his life to Jesus and a woman hearing prayers to Jesus in Turkish that were spoken in English! Others are praying to Jesus for the first time and are contemplating having a relationship with God through Jesus.

I'm so grateful to be a part of a church family that believes in sending to the nations. Through Jubilee's generosity, I got to see all these things with my own eyes and will carry them with me for the rest of my life."

#### **Armenia**

#### KAREN KHACHATRYAN, LEADER, RHEMA MOVEMENT OF CHURCHES

Baptisms in Artsakh: "In Artsakh, where new churches are being planted in three villages, we had the baptism of six young people, who are now actively involved in the church."

The Ministry to Farsi Speakers: "We celebrated 16 people being baptized in the Yerevan church, eight of them are Persians. It is encouraging that our group of Farsi speakers are actively growing! Currently there are about 60 people total, of which 30 attend the worship service every Sunday!"

New Church Plant in the City of Abovyan: "We are happy to announce that a new church plant has launched in the city of Abovyan, located about 20 kilometers north of Yerevan. Around 20 young people are coming together to worship Jesus every Sunday and hear the Word of God."

#### **BAPTISMS**

#### RYAN REED, JUBILEE THE LAKE LOCATION

"As a part of the Army, I suffered a back injury. I got angry and blamed God for taking everything away from me. In that darkness, I turned to drinking, drugs and thoughts of suicide. Thankfully, God put Danny and James into my life. One day, they prayed for me before going out to fish. A few minutes turned into four hours of experiencing Jesus. We never made it out to fish. Danny regularly pointed me to the Word and the spark for the Lord started to grow. I have walked away from my old life, away from the drinking and drugs and into the way the Lord has called me to live. I am going to lay everything at His feet and be washed clean."

#### STEPHEN LUNDRY, JUBILEE STL CITY LOCATION

"Growing up, I knew the things I was supposed to know but did not have a relationship with God. The following decade was full of self will and troubles with addiction. In a moment of grace, I turned back toward God and away from the things I thought I wanted. As I look back, I see the way God has softened my heart to hear His messages. He never abandoned me, even when I would not have Him. Today I know Jesus has saved me from sin and death. He is the only way to salvation."

#### BROOKE PARMELEY, JUBILEE STL CITY LOCATION

"In my very first shift as a pediatric nurse, I took care of a sweet baby girl named Mila Martin. I was given the opportunity to care for her for three months. I was so inspired by the faith Mila's parents (Brad and Renee) had during such a difficult time in their lives.

Fast forward to 2022, I found myself struggling from a lack of purpose. I came across a post Renee had shared on social media, so I decided to reach out to her and share how inspiring her love for God was. She invited me to Jubilee's 25th anniversary service. Renee connected me with a Community Group. This was outside of my comfort zone, but I somehow got the courage to go and I am so glad I did. I felt so welcome and genuinely cared for and encouraged. I gave my life to Jesus and was baptized the summer of 2023. I have experienced His saving grace and have now found my purpose is to live my life for God and to share my faith with others."

#### BECKY ZEIGLER, JUBILEE SUNSET HILLS LOCATION

"I truly believe in God's grace and mercy. I can finally be at peace and believe that God has truly forgiven me—that He's got me and that I can trust Him with the good and bad things in life. At a Jubilee service about six months ago, I gave my life to Jesus because I love and trust in Him."

#### JONAHA THOMAS, JUBILEE STL CITY LOCATION

"At age 19, I fell into a spiral of worldly living and putting myself in questionable situations with questionable people. After years of that life, I got tired of feeling this way. So I got on my knees and started praying to whoever would listen and God answered. A fire soon burned within me to seek God and I asked Him to reveal Himself to me. He removed distractions and drew me closer to Him. I saw the true nature of God—His grace, mercy, peace, kindness, patience, love and so much more. I found myself running to Him instead of from Him. God became everything that I needed. He is my hope. I have new life because of Jesus and will follow Him the rest of my days."

#### MAN CAMP AND DEEPLY ROOTED

He wants to tear that protection/that bag open. He wants me to fully surrender my heart and my life. I just pictured Him and I running and laughing and playing on the beach, and felt this invitation that when I surrender fully, I can live with fullness of joy and freedom. He wants nothing in between us."

#### The Path: A Discipleship Journey

This year Rick Hein has prayerfully and thoughtfully developed a discipleship tool called *The Path* which exists as a tool to help the local church fulfill the Great Commission of disciples who make disciples. We find this in Matthew 28:18–20, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them to observe all that I Have commanded you. And behold I am with you always to the end of the age." The Path consists of four, six-week phases called "Trailheads." While rooted in scripture, The Path is not a Bible Study or theology course. The goal is not the transfer of information, but the transformation of life. The content is simply the tool to help accomplish the goal of making disciples who make disciples.

#### RICK HEIN, ELDER, WASHINGTON LOCATION

"I spoke with several of our Confluence family leaders across the country and it became clear that there are two areas of ministry that have a huge opportunity for growth: evangelism and discipleship.

All of us are called to be discipled and make disciples. You can have significant influence in other people's walk with God. My hope is to have material that will help people get a hold of how they can do it. All of us can point to specific people in our lives who have come alongside us and had a huge influence on our walk with God. There's no spiritual gift of discipleship, we are all called to make disciples. I want to be able to put something in people's hands to where they could say, 'I could meet with somebody.'"


