



#My Jubilee Bible

Dear Jubilee Families,

As we embark on a Bible-reading plan together as a church, we recognize an incredible opportunity to help engage Jubilee's children in regular Bible reading.

Our desire at Jubilee is that all of our children would grow to cherish God's true and holy word! Understanding that Biblical family discipleship can feel challenging, especially in a day and age when schedules are jam packed and time with our children can feel rushed, we want to equip families to make the most of every opportunity by building family discipleship into their daily lives. Below you will find a list of resources and ideas for getting your family engaged in Bible reading together.

- 1) Our JKids curriculum, The Gospel Project, includes ideas for family Biblical discussion on the activity page your child brings home each week. On the right-hand side you'll find a summary of the story taught, family discussion questions, and even an activity to do together as a family that helps to reinforce the truths from scripture taught during class time. Every class, from nursery through upper-elementary, studies the same story each week so the entire family can participate! This is a great resource to use on the car ride home from church or before bed as a family on Sunday nights. (For all ages.)
- 2) The Jesus Storybook Bible is an incredible resource for kids (and adults) of all ages. As it goes chronologically through the stories in scripture, it describes how each one connects to the greater story of scripture: that Jesus came to rescue, redeem, and reconcile us to God. A great way to begin reading the Bible together as a family is to read one Bible story together before bed. Then, you can engage even young children in discussion by asking questions like:
 - What does this story teach us about God?
 - What does this story teach us about us?
 - How does this story point us to Jesus? (For all ages.)
- 3) For older kids who might be ready to begin reading the Bible independently but don't know where to start, The Bible App by Life.Church (the same app Jubilee's adults will be using) has a Bible-reading plan for kids titled "Love This Book Kids". This plan takes children through the Bible chronologically. It's broken up into 4 parts and each day contains a short passage of scripture (about 5-10 verses) as well as a simple explanation of what was read. We will also provide a printable version of this plan for kids who don't have devices or for families who prefer their children use a physical Bible rather than a Bible app. (For elementary-aged independent readers.)
