Dear Jubilee Volunteers:

We hope this letter finds you well! Our Re-opening Task Force has been considering our approach to begin gathering in person once more. Out of love for you and the many we serve on Sunday mornings, we have created new practices so our services will be safe, spacious, and sanitized.

#### HERE IS WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT:

#### SAFE

- *In light of city and county requirements, we will be requiring masks 9 and up to enter into the facility.*
- *We will check temperatures as volunteers arrive.*
- *All volunteers will wear masks which will be provided.*
- *Gloves will be used during set up.*
- *Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building.*
- *Children will receive a visual health screen and temperature scan before class.*

#### SPACIOUS

- *The parking lot and sidewalk leading to the building will be used as the new foyer in order to accommodate social distancing guidelines.*
- *Rows and aisles will be spaced six feet apart in the auditorium.*
- *Paths will be clearly marked for entering and exiting the building.*
- *Jkids classrooms will function at reduced capacity.*

#### SANITIZED

- *New cleaning protocols/checklists will be implemented.*
- *Sanitizing solutions according to CDC recommendations will be provided.*
- *All surfaces will be disinfected.*
- *A no touch/low touch environment will be created.*

I want to thank you for taking these safety precautions seriously as they will demonstrate to people just how much we love them. They represent more than just a list of best practices, but will be the avenue through which we will help people know God, find family, discover purpose and make a difference.
