Dear Jubilee Church:

Our Re-opening Task Force has been evaluating our Sunday morning service. Out of love for you and the many we serve on Sunday mornings, we have implemented new practices so that our services will be safe, spacious, and sanitized.

#### HERE IS WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT:

### SAFE

- *In light of city and county requirements, we will be requiring masks 9 and up to enter into the facility.*
- *Seating is limited in both adult and kids space*
- *Reserving a seat for the service is required to attend*
- *Go to [jubileestl.org](http://jubileestl.org) to reserve a seat in the adult/child space. Reservation is required*
- *All volunteers will have their temperature checked and will wear masks provided by Jubilee*
- *On Sunday you will see new signage that gives direction and welcomes you*
- *Greeters will greet you on the parking lot wearing masks and holding welcome signs*
- *Greeters and Ushers will open the doors for you as you enter the building, classrooms, and auditorium*
- *Disposable masks will be available for everyone who attends*
- *Pre-packaged communion elements have been placed on a table by a masked and gloved volunteer. The cups are spaced so that you can safely take one for each of your family members without touching any other cup. Please take one before you enter the auditorium*
- *Ushers will take you to a seat in the auditorium or direct you to Jkid check in*
- *You can potentially come in and leave without touching a single person.*
- *Jkids check-in/out process, volunteer staff and classroom procedures have been updated to keep our classrooms safe, spacious and sanitized.*

### SPACIOUS

- *Social distance stickers are placed on the floor in high traffic areas to maintain 6' spacing*
- *Ropes/dividers will be in place to help with traffic flow*
- *The usher team will help you find a seat*
- *Every other row of chairs has been removed or roped off to keep guests approximately 6 feet apart with 3 chairs between family units. Ushers will place social distance spacers on the chairs between family units.*
- *When exiting, the usher team will assist at each exit and dismiss the main auditorium by rows*
- *Families will check out their children from Jkids. Please maintain 6' of space between you and other families who are checking out their kids*

### SANITIZED

- *The building will be cleaned and disinfected before service*
- *Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the building*
- *We have implemented sanitizing guidelines as recommended by the CDC*
- *Our teams will clean and disinfect frequently when the building is in use (doors, counters, restrooms, Jkids spaces, etc.)*
- *Volunteers will wear gloves during set up to keep surfaces clean*
